- Rangers assisted Sheriff Department on a robbery call where the suspect vehicle was found by the Waterton Access. Some property was recovered but it appears suspect fled the area via the levee.
- Nimbus Dam released 80,000 CFS from Folsom Dam causing flooding along the majority of the American River Parkway. The American River Parkway parks were closed for a significant time during February for public safety during this high river event. Sections of the Dry Creek Parkway were also closed due to flooding issues as were two of the three properties in the Delta.
- Major clean-up effort at Deer Creek Hills
- Rangers assisted PGE with a down power line and tower at ARP mile 3, which fell during the storms and high river flows.
