

All trips include:

- ♦ Transportation, including airfare and rental vehicles as needed
- ♦ Hotel accommodations for 2 travelers per room with 2 beds; unless we are renting a house, then each person will have a bed, but may be more than 2 to a room
- ♦ Scheduled itinerary, with many opportunities to help make plans
- ♦ Fun activities and entertainment
- ♦ Admission to places of interest
- ♦ 24-hour staff supervision
- ♦ Fun-filled memories with new and old friends alike

Important Information:

- ♦ Some trip costs do not include meals. Each traveler will be responsible for bringing money for food and spending money. When possible, we stay in hotels with a free breakfast to save on costs.
- ♦ Once accepted, a deposit will be requested. Payments can be made up to 15 days prior to trip date.
- ♦ Trips are staffed at a 1:6 staff-to-participant ratio. Attendants may be able to be accommodated if ratio cannot be met, and will be required to cover travel costs.
- ♦ Cancellation Policy: Refunds will be given with 60 days cancellation notice; less than 60 days will be considered on a case-by-case basis and if spot can be filled

If you are interested in any of the trips, fill out the Travel Application and return as soon as possible. **Do not send money!** Your payment will be requested upon acceptance.
