• <u>Other Incidents</u>

Rangers assisted Sacramento County Sheriff Deputies with a shooting investigation on the bridge between River Bend Park and William Pond Park. One individual was shot and was transported to the hospital with non-life threatening wounds. The Sheriff's Department took the lead on this investigation.

Rangers also assisted the Sheriff Department by searching River Bend Park for a suspect who fled an assault with a deadly weapon (firearm) from a surrounding neighborhood. The suspect was not located within the park.

Rangers assisted with a death investigation on the American River Parkway under the Howe Avenue bridge. This death was ruled suspicious and turned over the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department to investigate. There was also an assault with a deadly weapon investigation at one of our Delta parks involving a suspect setting fire to another person at the Cliff House parking lot. This crime occurred prior to Rangers being on duty, so the Sheriff's Department was dispatched and handled the investigation and will continue to handle the follow up investigation.
