- Nimbus Dam released 60,000 CFS from Folsom Dam causing flooding along several portions of the American River Parkway. The Majority of the American River Parkway parks were closed for public safety during this high river event. Sections of the Dry Creek Parkway were also closed due to flooding issues.
