#### • Other Incidents

- Rangers responded to a death investigation along the American River Parkway by Northgate. This death was determined to be a suicide. There was an accidental drowning by Jibboom Street Bridge. A male subject was fleeing from Sacramento Police and tried to swim across the river and did not make it. He was pronounced dead at the hospital. Sacramento Police is the lead in this investigation.
- Sacramento Police and Rangers responded to a homicide in the Woodlake area of the American River Parkway. The victim was a homeless male. Sacramento Police is the lead agency in the investigation.
- Rangers assisted by the Sacramento County Sheriff are investigating a disturbance which turned into an assault with a deadly weapon (baseball bat) at Ancil Hoffman

Park. There was a disturbance involving two groups and one person was hit in the head with a baseball bat. A car was also damaged in the disturbance. No arrests were made and the investigation continues.

- Ranges assisted in rescuing three stranded rafters by William Pond. Their raft deflated but they made it to the island and called 911. Fire rescue boat was dispatched and brought the family to shore. On Father's Day, a 15 year old female became submerged in the River along the American River Parkway by mile marker 15.5. A friend of the family was able to pull her out of the river and revive her. She was not wearing a life jacket. Rangers and Sacramento Metro Fire assisted 3 stranded rafters at Anderson Island after their raft overturned.
- Sacramento City Fire and Rangers arrested a person for arson in the Lower American River Parkway/Discovery Park area. Fire personnel witnessed a man trying to start a couple of cottonwood trees on fire.

We have changed the format for tracking our illegal camping data. We will now be tracking the total number of illegal camps cleared, total number of illegal camping citations, and amount of debris removed from Regional Parks.
