#### • Other Incidents

- The Office of Emergency Services activated Region IV for law enforcement mutual aid to the Camp Fire in Butte County. We were able to assist by sending four Rangers on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday over the Veterans Day weekend and four days prior to Thanksgiving. I am proud of how my staff stepped up without hesitation to volunteer to help Butte County Sheriff during this devastating fire. Rangers stepped up to make sure we were appropriately staffed here at home as well. The stories they returned with were heartbreaking.
- Rangers responded to a death investigation along the American River Parkway by the Arden Garden connector. At this time, there were no signs of foul play and the Coroner is taking the lead on this case. A casualty report was prepared pending the outcome of the autopsy.
